

BARANGAY HISTORY

The first barrio to on line before reaching the wide Hacienda Jacinto is Bantug Hacienda. It is located just next to Barangay Gulod. Bantug Hacienda is formerly a part of then Sitio Gulod of Barangay Sibul. It is first called Bantug Hacienda during the term of President Ramon Magsaysay. “Bantug” is an Ilocano term meaning “higher than the other land around it”. One of the first Ilocano folk to dwell in the place gave such name to the barrio.

Among the first residents of Bantug Hacienda include Pablo Rivera (the one who gave the name of the barrio), Vicente Baldedara, Procopio Baldedara, Feliciano Baldedara, Heremias Catacutan, Eduardo Baldedara, Eulalio Mendoza, Juan Peralta, Leopoldo Grospe, Alfonso Baldedara, Esteban Salvatierra, Nicolas Reyes and Gregorio Oria. The first dwellers mostly came from Quezon, N. E., Rosales, Pangasinan, San Miguel and Baliwag Bulacan.

The patron saint of the place is Sto. Niño.
