

BARANGAY HISTORY

Barangay Bulac is the farthest barangay of Talavera, among the barrio is situated 2 kilometers away from the barrio of Tagaytay. The Calabinan Creek is also situated in this place which is diverted into an irrigation dike to water the fields of Hacienda de Leon owned by Kapitan Pepe de Leon.

It was in the year 1912 when the first settlers came in the place. They became former tenants of which are formerly owned by Don Gabriel Llamas. The dwellers were Ilocanos/Pangasinense which comes from the town of Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan. They are Julian Antonio, Gregorio Sotto, Emillio Sotto, Teodoro Barbosa, Guillermo Moises, Modesto cabico, Mauricio Bacolores, Rufo Zapatero, Leoncio Zapatero, Primitivo Reganit, Protacio Antonio, Cenon Cabanes and Marcelo Collado.

While they are still on search of the place, the researchers found 3 piles of tall and old Bulak (Cotton) trees. They were really amazed when they found the trees, since they knew that this Bulak (Cotton) threes will only grow on piles if it was directly planted. However, they were still uncertain if it was directly planted. Because of this unusual situation, the first dwellers names the place Bulac (Cotton), which is then composed of only few houses.

When the Hacienda was bought and Transferred to Kapitan Pepe de Leon, they built a small chapel. The patron saint of the place is Sta. Florencia whose image was donated by Dna. Narcisa de Leon, Kapitan Pepe's wife. The rehabilitation of irrigation canals provided an abundant harvest for them. The feast day of the place is during every month of April. They also celebrate their annual thanksgiving during this month.

The former peaceful town turned otherwise, when the Japanese invaded the place upon learning that the Filipino revolutionaries were hiding in the place. The Japanese troops raided Barangay Bulac, Tabacao and Culdit once again, resulted to the killing of the Barangay Captain Crispulo Cardenas, a suspected pro – guirillas.

In 1948, Bulac dwellers vacated the place and went to the National Highways, others went to San Jose to escape from the assault of the Japanese constabularies under the symbol "Markang Bungo".

They returned to their place which is totally wrecked and damaged by the eruption. However barrio folks, who are equipped with natural industry, they once gain rehabilitated the place.
