

BARANGAY HISTORY

Barangay Dimasalang Norte Started as a small sitio of San Ricardo, which is composed of group of houses. The sitio was first called Pulong Inyog (group of coconut trees), since coconut trees are dominant in the place. Until later the sitio started to change for good. People continued to reside in the place, until such time that the residents decided to change its name. They named the place Sarangaya which named after a certain Juana Sarangaya, an old woman who bought big parcels of land in the place.

The first “Tunylene del Baryo” is Eustaquio Marcos (1931 – 1953), next is Benigno Arellano in 1960, Placido Cunanan in 1964, Danilo Pineda in 1966, Bonifacio dela Cruz in 1970, Domiciano Corpuz in 1975, and Castillo Legaspi in 1978

However, as years passed by since there is a big number of residents, they requested through a resolution that the sitio Pulo – pulo be separated from the barrio of San Ricardo. That’s why in 1968, the then Mayor Bonifacio F. de Jesus got a copy of an order from the Provincial Government, proclaiming the place Pulong Inyog as a regular barrio. However, they changed the name to Dimasalang Norte, taken from the word Dimasalang (Cannot be broken), taken from the idea that the word of God cannot be broken.

The first school building was constructed during the term of Mayor Bonifacio de Jesus and then Barangay Captain Eduardo Marcos. It was a Marcos typed building erected in a ½ hectare land donated by barangay Captain Marcos. It was able to accommodate Grades I – III Pupils.
