

## BARANGAY HISTORY

Gulod is a former Sitio just like Sampaloc and Balasiwak. It was named “Gulod” because the place has the highest level of land among the three sitios. Gulod, however means higher level of land. Gulod is located just next to Sampaloc and a one and a half-kilometer east of Poblacion. When Sampaloc became a separate barangay, sitio Gulod became part of Sampaloc, so it was named Sampaloc-Gulod. Gulod was only separated from Sampaloc, by virtue of a Municipal Order in 1946.

Gulod, just like the origin of the other barangays, is just like a forest wherein wild plants and trees grew. However, migrants from other places went to the place to clear it and at the same time dwell on it. The idea of migrating however came to their mind because they want to search something new for their fate.

Among the first settlers however, was enumerated in the History of barangay Sampaloc. When Gulod separates from barangay Sampaloc in 1946, they elected their own officials. Among the first to become “Tinyente del Barrio”, were Marcos Miranda, Gaspar Lacanilao and Maximo Monje.
