

## BARANGAY HISTORY

Matias District was established in 1972, by virtue of an Executive Order of the Mayor Bonifacio F. de Jesus. The first name of this Barangay is Purok Luna. The first barangay officials was appointed by the said Mayor, Ramon B. Garcia became the first Barangay Captain, and the six members of the Sangguniang Barangay were Casiano Santos, Manuel Yauco, Cesario Mata, Ponciano Mercado, Domingo Perez and Esutaquio del Mundo.

It was during the term of barangay Captain Garcia, when a resolution changing the name Matias District had passed. Matias was chosen to honor the late Jose Matias who happened to be the barangay council's adviser and the donor of a lot where the barangay plaza is located.

The first regular barangay election was held in 1982. This was won by Ramon B. Garcia. He is the first elected barangay Captain. The six members of the sangguniang Barangay were Roberto C. Banal, Danilo M. Reyes, Alfredo T. de Guzman, Modesta G. Ferrer, Ponciano Mercado, and Isabelo M. Cena.
