

## BARANGAY HISTORY

Paludpod is just like a forest before wherein tall trees of different varieties, wild grasses and some other plants grew. Some says wildlife also lived in the place. And the place has no name then.

Paludpod got the name, just like others who's got their barangay names by a word which is oftenly said. The name Paludpod was derived from the word "Pala-upod" (deteriorating). This name starts during the Spanish regime, a very tall tree was seen deteriorating, leaves are slowly falling from the branches and the part from the top is breaking slowly so they exhumed that the tree is deteriorating (or malapit nang maupod).

Accordingly, when somebody came to ask the name of the place, people just say "Sa puno na malapit nang ma UPOD", until such time that the place was called "PALUDPOD" even before it was recognized as a barangay.

Paludpod became its official name when it was recognized as a barangay in 1946 elected its own "Tinyente del Baryo"
