

BARANGAY HISTORY

Pantoc Bulac is formerly a part of Barangay Bulac and is composed of two groups of houses which are located in the south and the southern part of Bulac. Pantoc Bulac however, became a separate barangay, when the whole Hacienda de Leon was divided by the Land Tenure Administration. Pantoc bulac was considered the smallest barangay of Talavera having a total land area of 50 hectares.

Among the first settlers of Talavera were Ilocanos from Quezon, Agbannawag, Rizal and San Carlos, Pangasinan. It was in the year 1925 when they first landed to clear the place, which is then apart of Hacineda de Leon. The first settlers include, Martin Gamino, Alberto Ramos, Antonio Hipolito, Alfredo Gamino, Leoduvico Irang, Juan Sacatrapos, Florentino Irang, Ireneo Zulueta, and Pedro Sacro. After a while, Pablo Alimbango, Amado Aquino, Aquilino Angel, Pablo Francisco, Santiago Agbannawag, and Eugenio Gamino owns their respective lots in the place.

The place was called Pantoc, not only because of the higher level of land where they built their houses, but the place where they are planting their vegetables is likewise higher than the land of the neighboring barrio.

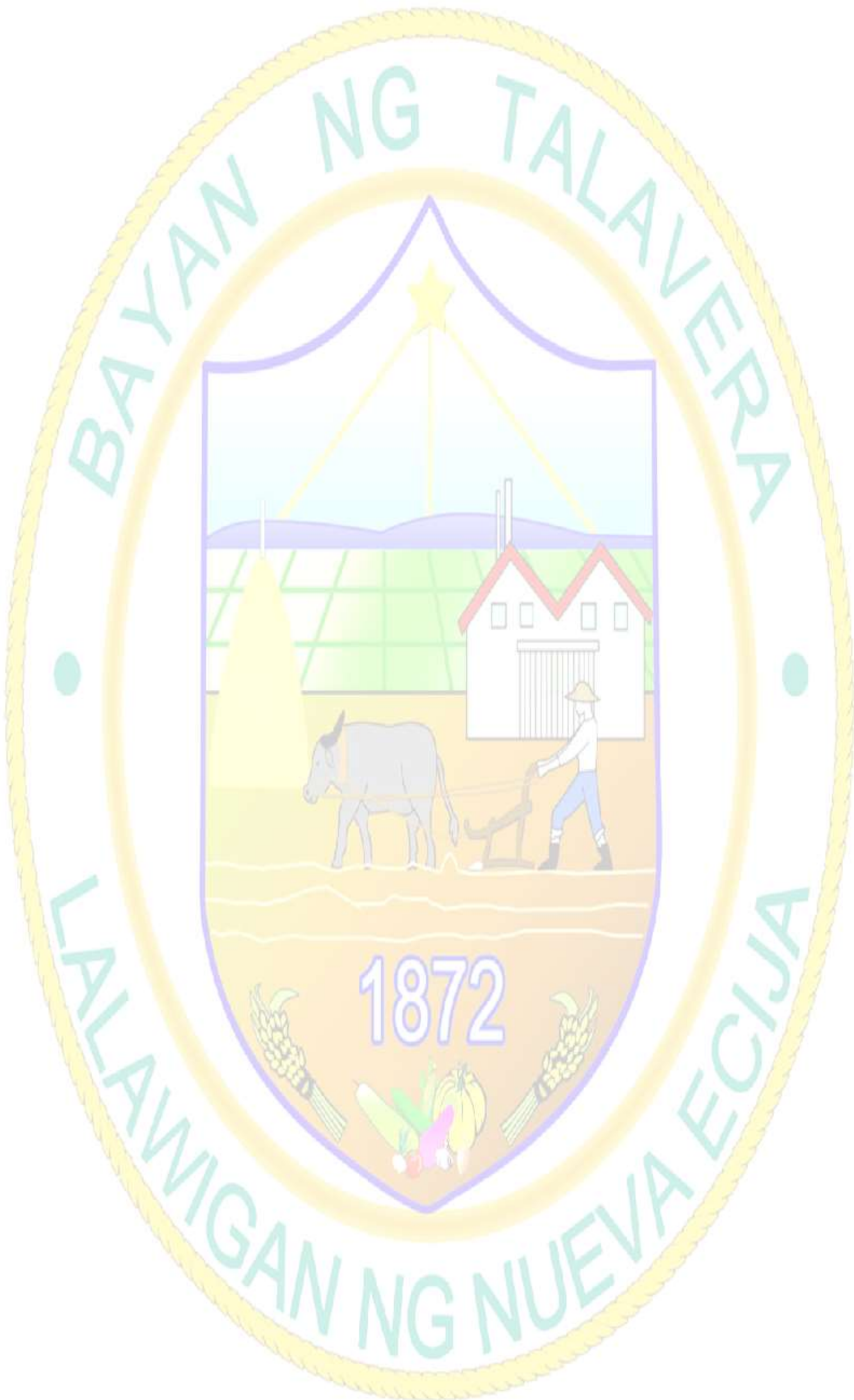
