

## BARANGAY HISTORY

Barangay Sibul is just a place, which is like a forest, wherein tall trees and wild grew. First settlers of the place clear the area until people came to reside in the place. During the term of the Mayor Timoteo Parungao, people noticed a spring in the centerpoint of the area. It was in this spring where people of the place got source of potable water and to use in their water needs. From then on, they named their place Sibul, which means something, comes from nowhere, since the spring came from nowhere.

The first “Tinyente del Baryo” of Sibul is Laureano Bautista. He held the post until 1948. Next to him is Luis dela Cruz.

Even before the Second World War erupted school was built in Sibul. It was a humble building, made up of Nipa and other improvised materials. The school was temporarily closed and was only reopened in 1945. The small school started to be developed until it became a complete elementary school; Mr. V. Sanvicente became the first Principal, followed by Mrs. T. Cipriano, Mr. Narciso Joson and Mrs. Belen Viterbo

Among the first residents of Sibul who was elected in the municipal posts are Luis dela Cruz Municipal Councilor in 1960 and Camilo Fernandez, municipal Councilor in 1964 and Vice Mayor in 1967.
