

## BARANGAY HISTORY

Barangay Bagong Silang is formerly a part of Barangay Lomboy- Bulihan. The houses in this place are seen to be piled on both sides of the National Highway, before the bridge leading to Baloc, a barrio of Sto. Domingo.

According to the most senior citizens of the place, it is during the Spanish regime when the first residents came to clear the place, which is just like a forest. The first settlers were migrants from the nearby town of Licab, San Isidro and Quezon. Among them are, Jacinto Bonifacio, Lorenzo Bacton, Benigno Castro, Pedro dela Cruz, Agustin Tinio, Silverio David, Luis Cayanga, Gregorio Martin, Eulogio de Guzman, Mariano Mariano, Sebastian dela Cruz, Pastor Barlaan, Raquel Jimenez, Calixto Joson, Gonzalo Pablo, and emeteria dela Cruz.

The place was named Bagong Silang (Newly born), after the 2<sup>nd</sup> World War. Accordingly, after the war, the residents returned to the barrio from where they evacuated. Since they returned to their place united and unharmed, they decided to celebrate a thanksgiving feast. Nobody from their piles was harmed nor physically destroyed by the outbreak, so they decided to name the place "BAGONG SILANG" which means newlyborn, since they considered themselves having a new life after the war.
