

BARANGAY HISTORY

Long before the Japanese came to rule the place, Barangay Cabubulaunan was still dominated with towering variety of trees and wild grasses. In place dwells the first residents namely Pedro Manzano, Gorgonio Manzano, Elpidio Verdadero, Eduardo Somera, Victorino Bulusan who were all Ilocanos. This same people cleared the place after the war. They cut the grasses and started to beautify it. It is in this situation where they noticed that the land here is 'laon' (old type of land). Accordingly, 'laon' type of land is beautiful and very suitable to vegetables and other crops. When the place was totally cleared the place became the sitio of barangay Caputican and it was developed into a Hacienda by Jacinto and Baltao.

Vegetables and palay harvest here is abundant and very good, this is due to the type of land called "laon". Because of this good land, which produces good harvest, migrants from nearby barrios and towns went to dwell in the place, until it became a barrio. And due to the good harvest and produce from the LAON type of land. They named the place Cabubu-LAON-an.
