

BARANGAY HISTORY

Barangay Campus is a former sitio of Barangay Calipahan. It is here where the tenants of Hacienda Jacinto reside. They were mostly farm workers of Teodocio Valenton and Olivia Veneracion.

Just like the origin of all the places, Campus is just like a forest before the first dwellers arrive in the place. They built group of nipa huts for their temporary shelter, while they still clearing the place. They usually start working very early in the morning and went back in their houses late at night. They usually consider their place a 'kampo' (Camp), and in order to make the name of their place more beautiful, they called it Campos.

Among the first dwellers of the place are Nicolas Matias, Alfredo Tajorda, Jose Santiago, Tomas Salagsag, Fermin Pangan, Mariano Guillermo, Juan de Leon, Apolonio Francisco, Fidel Adriano, Silverio Salagsag, Pio Flamenco, Silvino Pingol, Esteban Tajorda, Esteban Verde, Mariano Sibayan, Dionisio Valdez, Santos de Leon, Leopoldo Santiago, Alejandro Mendoza, Jose Pagua, Tomas Manacop, Domingo Santiago, Victor Basa, Aniceto Galapon, Eulalio Manahan, Simon Bune, and Tiburcio Verde. They are from the town of Bustos, Baliwag, San Miguel and Malolos in Bulacan and others came from the town of San Jose, Guimba, Licab in Nueva Ecija. Some of them also came from Calipahan and Barangay San Pascual.

It is in the year 1920 when some additional dwellers resides in the place but it is only in 1942, right after the war when the residents of Campos decided to separate from Calipahan. From then on they managed their own administration through their newly elected Barangay Captain. Among the first Barangay Captains to rule the place were Victor Laureano, Victor Luctu, Pablo Santiago, Jose Santiago, Pio Flamenco, Petronilo Santiago, and Albino dela Cruz.
