

BARANGAY HISTORY

One of the most remote barrio of Talavera is barangay Casulucan Este. It is located 12 kilometers away from the town of Talavera and it became part of the Hacienda de Leon. The barangay is Talavera's boundary to the town of Munoz and Sto. Domingo. Casulucan Este is just beside Casulucan, a barrio of the town of Sto. Domingo where which the barangay got its name.

In 1921, Casulucan Este is formerly called by the name Kinamatayan, because of a certain tragedy which happens in this forest liked place, and it goes like this:

“A certain Damaso killed Anatalia by stabbing. Anatalia is the girl whom Damaso is courting. Accordingly, Anatalia rejected Damaso's proposal, this opted Damaso to kill the girl. Both of them however, were from the nearby barrio of Tabacao. Anatalia is passing in the area whenever she is selling vegetables to the town of Munoz. “

After the war, Kinamatayan was changed to Sibalod , since Sibalod creek can be found in the center of the barangay, until it was changed once again to Casulucan Este after Hacienda de Leon was divided into lots and was given to the people.

Settlers of the place were all Ilocanos from Sto. Domingo, Quezon, Guimba of Nueva Ecija; Gerona and Tarlac in Tarlac and Candon, Sinit, Cabugao and Sta. Lucia in Ilocos Sur. Among the first settlers of the place were, Fausto Valentino, Victor Valentino, Mariano Sinense, Francisco Macapulay, Roman Ponce, Cecilio Alejo, Vicente Bergonio, Emiliano Valiente, Catalino Valdez, Sofronio Alamani, Gregorio Ponce, Cornelio Ibarra, Tomas Valentino, Mariano Valentino, and Roman Domingo. All of them first dwell in 1912.
