

BARANGAY HISTORY

The barrio of Dinarayat is just a small place composed of five houses, located between Barangay La Torre and Barangay Pinagpanaan. Small as it was none of the two barrios claimed ownership to the place. The place has no name yet, when Felipe Manuzon, an Ilocano hunter who among the few residents of the place came hunting, a deer in Umangan. The deer which he caught escaped when he was at Pinagpanaan and escaped once again and ran in La Torre. On his way to get back the deer, he met an American national, who is asking few question which he doesn't understand. So he just replied "di ko kayat", an Ilocano word meaning "I don't like".

However, it so happened that the American is only asking for the name of the place, so he thought the name is Dinarayat (since he pronounce it in a slang manner). "Di ko kayat" was pronounced by the said American as "Dinarayat".

Thus, in 1912 this small barrio which is located between Barangay La Torre and Barangay Pinagpanaan is named Dinarayat as a result of misunderstanding between the American national and the Ilocano hunter.

The history is relayed by Mr. Etineto Francisco, a 75 years old, senior citizen of the place.
