

## BARANGAY HISTORY

Homestead I is among the three sitios of Pinagpanaan. The other two are Homestead II and Baluga. The three sitios before the third World War was ruled by only one "Tinyente del Baryo". When the Japanese colonizers came, together with the Filipinos who were on their side organized the so-called neighborhood association. This prompted the division of the three barrios. The situation however normalized when the American came in 1946 to save the Filipinos. However, barangay Homestead II separated from the two, and elected its own barangay officials. While Baluga and Homestead I continued with its merger, they had one "Tinyente del Baryo", common church, common feast and common barangay activities.

Then in 1955, Barangay Homestead I decided to separate from Baluga. They constructed their own church building and elected their own barangay officials.

Sources said that Homestead I got its name from the first dwellers who owned rights of the land through the style of homesteading.
