Homestead is just a sitio of Barangay Pinagpanaan, and a few part of the area is from San Ricardo. However, the then mayor Teodocio Valenton, together with the people agreed to divide the place into two, and both was then recognized as two separate barrios. They were Barangay Homestead I and II.
