

BARANGAY HISTORY

Barangay Lomboy is composed of three groups of houses. It is situated just next to Barangay San Pascual. The first group is in the western part, they were among the farmer/tenants of Hacienda Gonzales. In the northern part were the farmer/tenants of the Paulino's, and in the eastern part which is the biggest group is the farmer/tenants of the Valenton's.

Accordingly, Lomboy is very far from the so-called civilization. The only visible in the area is a narrow road from the northern part going to the south, wherein Ilocano merchants are passing. They are all riding in their horses to sell their merchandise in the nearby town or in Manila. Sources said, that one day, while the said merchants passed on the place, they noticed a tall fruit-bearing tree which is popularly known in Ilocano as Lomboy (in Tagalog, it is duhat, a violet colored native fruit). The fruit bears so many fruits that time, so they ran after each other to get their place, Lomboy, which was named after the fruit.

The first settlers of the place were from the towns of Alcala, Tayug, San Quintin, Rosales, and Manaog in Pangasinan. Others came from Nampicuan, Guimba, Aliaga and Cabanatuan while others came from San Miguel and Malolos in Bulacan.

The patron saint of Lomboy is San Roque, and the feast day is every 16th of August.
