

## BARANGAY HISTORY

Barangay Mabuhay is one of the barangay's of Talavera, Nueva Ecija. Formerly a Sitio named "CULDIT" of barangay Collado, and located on the North side and along the territorial boundaries are; on the East side, by barangay Caaninaplahan, and along the East side also by Barangay Kinalanguyan.

During that time, according to some old residents, although it was a Sitio named "CULDIT" the residents to this place, in behalf of the first KATIWALA, the late Mr. Leopoldo Santiago gave its own name to remember and sounds beautifully and they famously called it Barangay Mabuhay, means full of life, sacrifice and success.

This land is formerly owned by Late Congressman Eugenio Baltao, Sr. Congressman First District of Nueva Ecija. And with a total Land Area of more or less 305 Hectares, 85% of this is Agricultural Land and some are Residential, According to the Department of Agrarian Reform.

Then in 1945, it was established and was fully developed. Years after, in 1950, this Sitio became a Barrio and separated from Barangay Collado, that time the first Tinyente del Barrio that was appointed is the late Mr. Dominador Vallarta.

In 1956, the second Tenyente del Barrio, was the late Mr. Hermogenes Cabrera, he was the one who passed the Resolution at the Sangguniang Bayan, requesting that this Sitio, become a registered Barrio Mabuhay, in Town of Talavera, Nueva Ecija.

Then, after his term in 1960, the third Tinyente del Barrio, was the late Mr. Celestino dela Fuente, during his term, he noted that the Resolution passed to the Sangguniang Bayan was approved and enacted, under Resolution Executive Order No. 3580.

Then the famous land became a registered barrio or barangay and it is popularly known as barangay "MABUHAY".
