

## BARANGAY HISTORY

Everything that so exists on this earth has its own origin. Records and data has been written and noted down by our ancestors in the past in order that the generation to come after them will have a knowledge and basis for their researches and information.

Long before the declaration of certain Presidential Decree which divide a Poblacion of every town into a district, Barangay Pulong San Miguel was already in existence and known to the entire citizenry of Talavera as Pulong Kapampangan, a name which connotes that the first settlers or inhabitants of the place was of Pampanga origin.

Barangay Pulong San Miguel derived its name from the name of the town where the first settlers originated, and the patron saint of the place, San Miguel Arcanghel. It is located in the heart of the town of Talavera, bounded in the south by Barangay Matias, in the north by Barangay Calipahan, in the east by the two barangays, Esguerra and Andal Alinio, and in the west by the Talavera river. Most of the inhabitants were merchants, market vendors, farmers and with some professionals. Its economic resources came from the vast track of lands mostly planted with different kinds of vegetables.
