

BARANGAY HISTORY

Barangay San Pascual is popularly called Siksikan before. This is because some evacuees from Luzon come when the World War erupted. The place was not so disturbed by the forces of war, since it is along Maharlika Highway that is why people go here for temporary dwellings. Most of the first settlers were from Bulacan and Pampanga and the richest haciendero here is Don Pascual Tinio. His land property is too big. Don Pascual is the one who donated the patron saint's image for the community. The patron saint of San Pascual Baylon and Sta. Clara like the patron saint of Obando in Bulacan. Their feast day is every 16th and 17th of May.

However, as years passed by, Don Pascual's land properties are transferred to Dna. Rosario Arnedo vda. De Gonzales who donated the lot where the elementary school and the barangay plaza is located.

From the original name Siksikan, this was changed to San Pascual in honor of the Patron Saint Pascual Baylon. San Pascual is considered as one of the first barangays of Talavera.

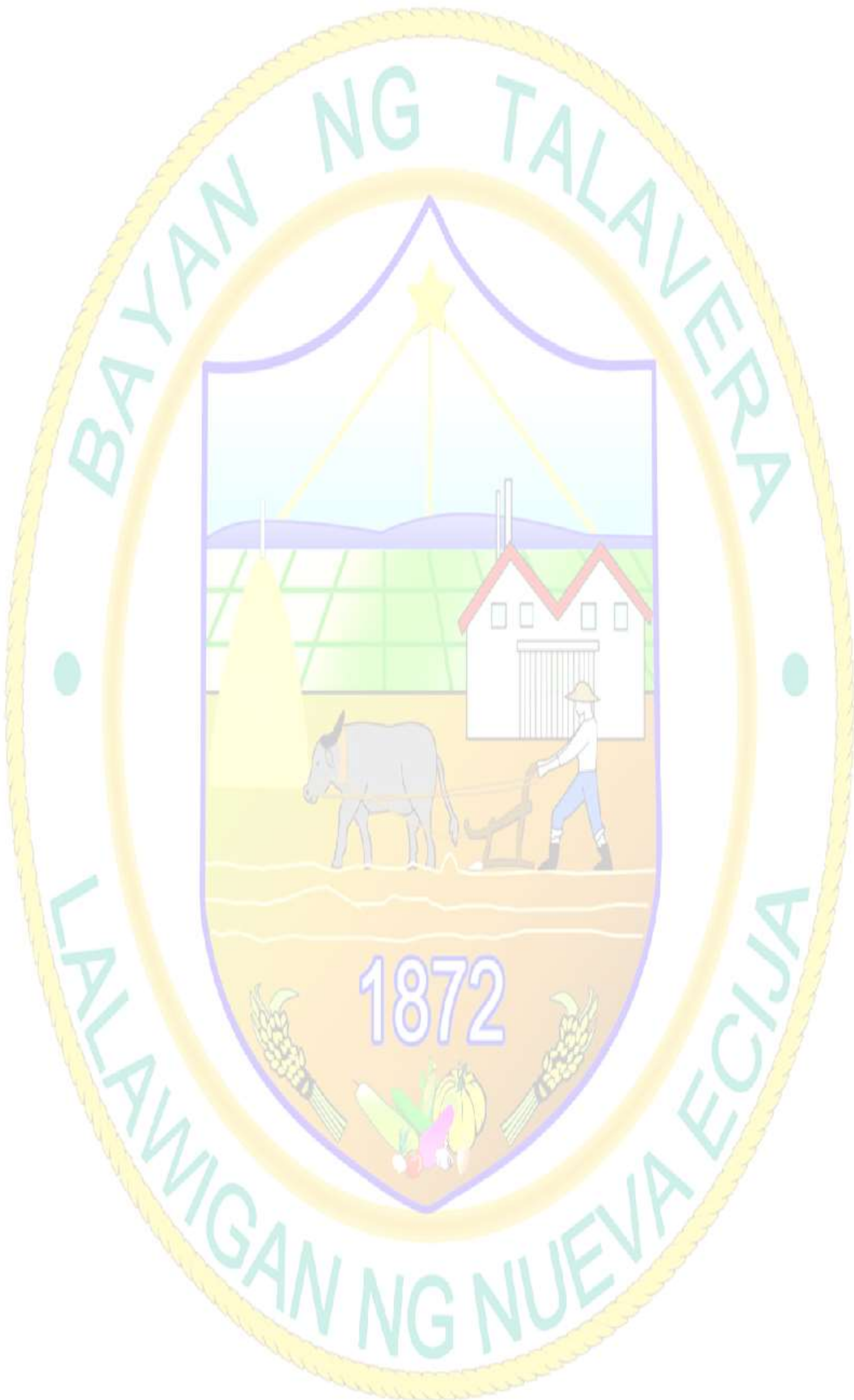

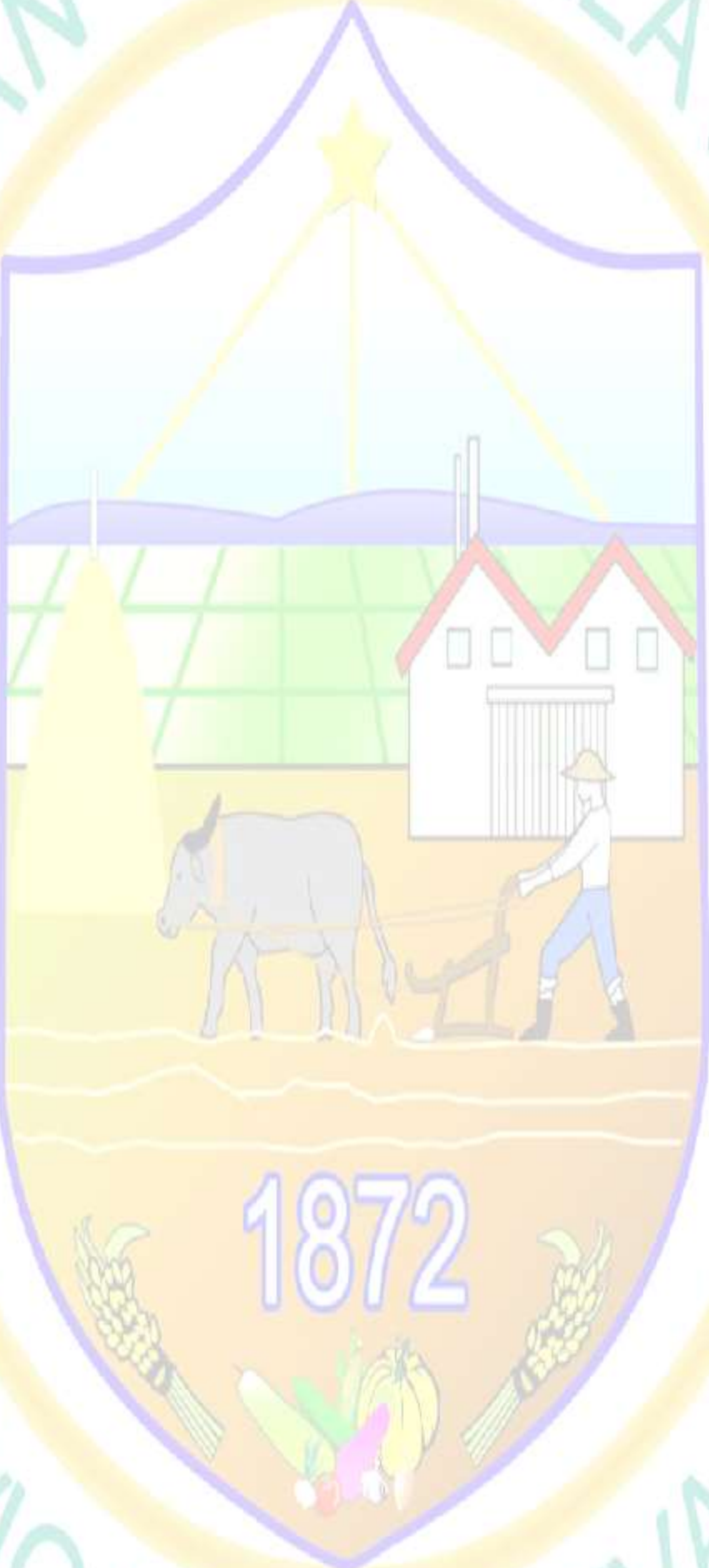
